### **Additional Instructions**

Rigid walls to be a minimum of 150mm thickness and have a minimum density of ≥650kg/m³.

Pillows should be installed lengthways and in such a way that all joints are staggered in each layer and all gaps are filled in a manner that ensures a tight compression fit.

Pillows should be finally positioned so that they are **centrally positioned** within the fire compartment wall with equal projection on both sides of the supporting construction.

Services are to be wrapped with additional 300mm long Quelfire Fire Pillows where they exit the seal. These pillows are positioned lengthways and are stitched together and supported in place with steel wire forming a continuous seal around the services.

BS EN 1366-3:2021 Section 13.7: The distance between the aperture edges of penetration seals in a building element shall be as tested or minimum 100mm. The distance between the aperture edge of a penetration seal and any other penetration (e.g., door) in a building element shall be minimum 200mm.
